Janine Prosper, who recently travelled to Israel, gave us an overview of the Pilgrimage at the Holy Land, which she described as an unforgettable experience.

She visited the following holy sites:-

Mont Sinai is the mountain at which the Ten Commandments were given to Moses by God.

The Ascension of Mont Sinai has been done at 23.30 hrs. by camel dromedary.

Saint Catherine's Monastery, which lies in the Sinai Peninsula. Saint Catherine's Monastery was constructed at the base of this mountain at a site which is claimed to be the site of the burning bush.

*According to the narrative, the bush was on fire, but was not consumed by the flames, hence the name – the **Burning Bush**.*

The Sinai monastery is said to be the oldest continuously active Christian monastery in the World. Library of the Sinai Monastery which is today a museum holds an impressive collection of holy manuscripts and iconography.

Only the Vatican Library in Rome has a larger collection of holy books than the library of Saint Catherine Monastery

Visit the Jordan River, where we had the opportunity to renew our baptismal vows

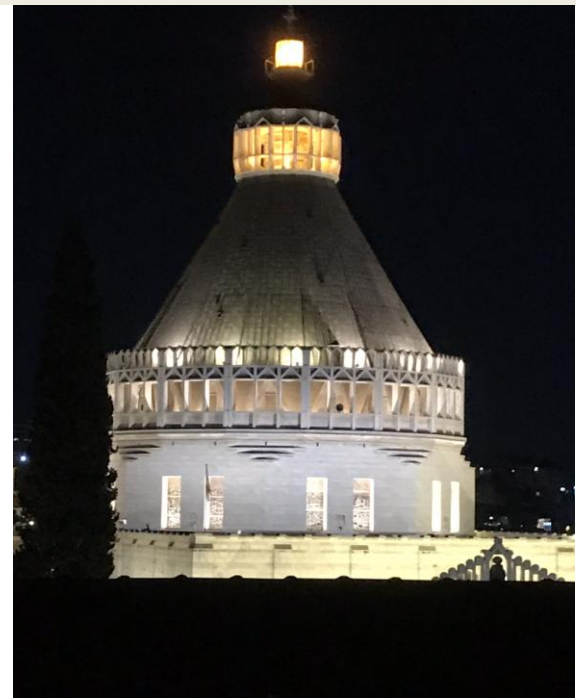
Jericho, Mt of Temptation

Mass at Cenacle. The Last Supper was the meal Jesus shared with his apostles the night before he died.

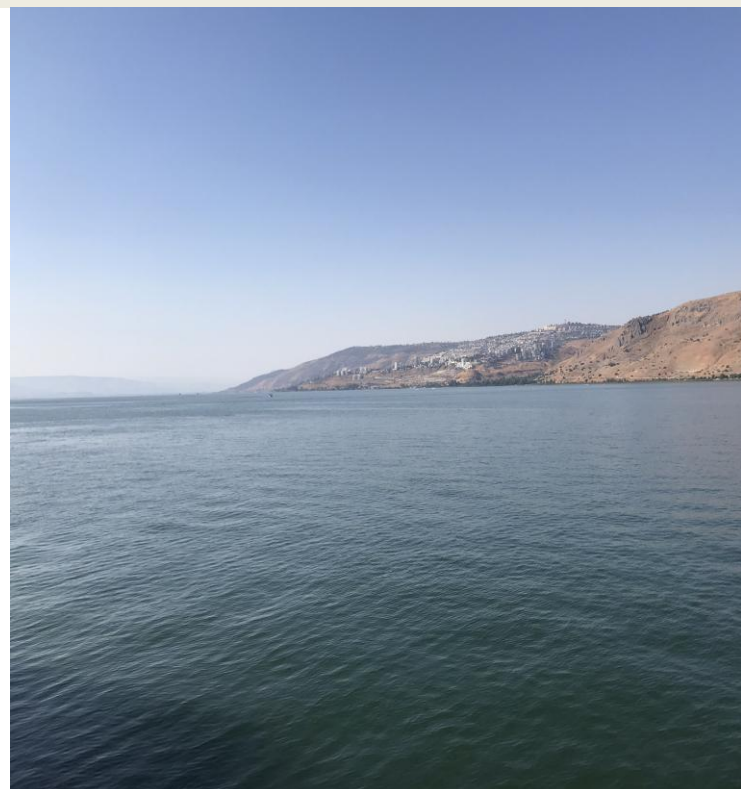
Mount Olives, where Jesus taught the Lord's Prayer to his disciples
