The purpose of Rangoli is decoration, but it is also thought to bring good luck. It is traditionally done by girls or women. Designs vary, as they reflect traditions, folklore, and practices that are unique to each area.

As you can see from the pictures, our designs were certainly varied. 3 groups of about 5 persons each were provided with coloured rice and a blank sheet of paper. The time allowed to do the Rangoli was 10 minutes before our judges made their selection of (in their opinion) the best attempt.
