### BREAKING THE SILENCE...

Susan Falatko, Charge d'Affairs, US Embassy to Mauritius and Seychelles, spoke to members on domestic violence. She pointed out that this was not only a WOMEN's issue and that the impact of such violence (both physical and emotional) is felt throughout society and across generations. This highly emotive subject elicited wide participation from members who shared stories and experiences.

Susan called on all of us to lobby our leaders for change in legislation and funding and, much closer to home, to "break the silence" by talking about (and encouraging others to talk about) incidents that affect our families and our neighbours. She encouraged us to give voice to the problem not just amongst women but stressed the need to recruit men as allies.

Originally from Chicago, Illinois, Susan joined the Foreign Service in 1999 as an Economic officer, and has served overseas in Bamako, Havana, Sarajevo, Geneva, and Kigali in both Economic and Public Diplomacy positions, as well as in Washington.
