In 1870 the Rault family started producing manioc biscuits at its little biscuit factory on the northern outskirts of Mahébourg, and the factory has hardly changed since. These cassava based cookies are made almost entirely by hand using a secret recipe passed down from generation to generation. The short tour ends with a chance to sample the finished product – with a nice cup of tea of course.
